



The Trinity Institute of Professional Studies, Dwarka organized a one-week Faculty Development Programme on "Use of Data Analysis in Research" from 16th Nov to 23rd Nov, 2023.

Day 1, Session I (16th Nov, 2023 (Thursday))

The Faculty Development Programme was inaugurated by Prof. Dr. Ashutosh Agarwal, Director of Trinity Dwarka. He introduced the objectives and importance of the FDP and welcomed all the participants. The first session of day 1 started with the deliberation of Prof. Dr. Rajesh Agarwal, HOD, BAJMC department, Trinity Dwarka. Dr. Rajesh talked about "Introduction of Research and Types of Research". He explained the meaning, objective and nature of research in detail. He also explained the problems a researcher may face in data collection and selecting an appropriate research design. He highlighted different types of research, mainly Applied Research, Basic Research, Descriptive Research, Exploratory Research, Explanatory Research, Co-relational Research, Longitudinal Research etc. with practical examples. At the end of the session, he addressed the queries of the participants. It was an insightful session.





(Adj), Metro Pillar No. 1360) Sector-9, Dwarka, New Delhi-110075 Pailpa Jain, Assistant Professor, USMS, GGSIP University was the second resource person of Day1. She ave insights on "How basics of Research enhance Data Analysis in a systematic way." She highlighted that a research proposal should always contribute to society. She explained the basic terms used in all type of research e.g. Significance level, Degree of freedom, Standard deviation and standard error in simple manner. She also highlighted that all statistical techniques used in research are based on calculating differences or relations. She gave insights on four types of data analytics -Descriptive (What happened), Diagnostic (Why did it happen), Predictive (What is likely to happen in future) and Prescriptive (What is the best course of action). In all four types of analytics, any statistical software calculates only the Descriptive part and the rest of the Analytics is applied by the researcher. At the end of the session, she addressed the queries of the participants.









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(17th Nov, 2023) Session I


The second day of FDP on "Use of Data Analysis in Research", Dr. Deepali Saluja, HOD, Management & Commerce department, Trinity Dwarka, addressed the participants on "Plagiarism: A Challenge in Research". She spoke on definition, meaning and growth of Plagiarism and highlighted the period from 2010 to 2015 in which highest plagiarism was observed in Indian research. She explained the types of plagriasm mainly – Direct, Self, Paraphrasing, Mosaic, Accidental and Global Plagiarism. She also told about the free and paid anti plagriasm softwares available for researchers. At the end of the session she presented various cases where Bollywood Movies and speech of the leaders are found to be copied.






Day 2 Session II

Dr Zubair Ahmed Khan, Associate Director, Research & Development Cell, GGSIP University was the Resource Person for the II session of FDP on day 2. He deliberated on the topic "Research Ethics and Plagiarism while analysing data in Research". He highlighted the importance of "Intellectual Hoensty – adherence to ethical principles" in research and gave 10 ethical principles for research. He also explained the meaning, types and levels of plagiarism. He emphsised on the need for establishing a Departmentl Academic Integrity Panel (DAIP) by all higher education institutes to deal with plagiarism related issues, which can submit its Action Taken Report within 45 days of receipt of any plagiarism related issue at institute level. He suggested various techniques e.g. Capacity Building Programmes and Awareness Compaign etc. to deal with plagiarism related issues. At the end of the session, Dr. Zubair involved all participants by giving an exercise on ethical challenges faced by them in pursuing research and discussed the issues with participants.





At the end of day 2 of FDP, Prof. Dr. Ashutosh Agarwal, Director, Trinity Dwarka and Prof. Dr. Shashi Bala, Principal (Law), Trinity Dwarka felicitated Dr. Zubair Ahmed Khan and Ms. Gaurika, Assistant Professor, Law Department, Trinity Dwarka, proposed vote of thanks. It was a very insightful session.



Day 3 (18th Nov, 2023) Session I

low Delhi-110075 Dr. Anjali Shokken, Assitant Professor, University School of Education, GGSIP university was the resource person for day 3 of Faculty Development Programme organised by Trinity Dwarka. She conducted an insightful session on "Usage and Importance of Statistical tools in Research". 




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Day 4 Session II

She highlighted the importance and explained why this technique is trending in each domain nowadays. She provided hands on trianing on how to select and filter data from database using an appropriate search query and use of softwares - Vosviewer and Biblioshinny to perform the analysis. She also explained how to find out the most influential authors, most influential documents, most frequently used keywords, citation and co-citation analysis and countries collaborations in a particular area using theses softwares. Day 5 (21st Nov, 2023) Session I

Dr. Ritika Wason, Deputy Director Bharati Vidyapeeth's Institute of Computer Applications and Management was the first resource person of day 5. She started the session with installation of R and R studio. She talked about the importance and use of R and R studio for data analysis. She explained the in-built packages in R studio and how to install packages as per the analysis requirements. She also explained how to import data from excel or SPSS in R studio and how the basic statistical functions can be performed. She discussed how analysis and graph can be exported from R studio to present in the report.

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Dr. Sheel Nidhi Tripathi, Associate Professor, BVICAM, Delhi was the second resource person of Day 5. Her topic of deliberation was "Lietrature Review Processing and writing". She described the importance, purpose and process of Literature Review and explained general guidelines to write literature review. She gave few tips to organise literature review. She explained some common errors made by the researchers in writing literature review and how the issue of plagiarism can be addressed in literature review. To make the technique of writing literature review more clear, she selected a reearch paper and applied the technique step by step.



Both the sessions of Day 5 were very insightful. Prof Dr. Ashutosh Agarwal, Director, Trinity Dwarka appreciated the resource persons and presented a token of gratitude to them and Dr. Sandhya Maitra, Deputy Director, Trinity Dwarka proposed vote of thanks.






Day 6 (22nd Nov, 2023) Session I

Dr. Naresh K. Vats, Assistant Professor, Department of Humanities & Social Sciences, GGSIP university, was the first resource person for day 6 of FDP. He shared his views on the topic "Importance of Qualitative Data in Research Paper." He highlighted that all Indian researchers are using US/UK based documentation style in research and not trying to develop our own Indian style. He tried to throw some light on the Indian literature e.g. Vyakyapadia and Katyanan that existed long before BC. Sir has justified the theme of the FDP by connecting it to our Indian Methodology of Research. He also discussed the usefulness of qualitative data where human behaviour, perception and conciousness is involved in research. The qualitative research explores and provides deeper insights. It was a thought provoking session for the researchers.





Dr. Mukta Sharma, HOD, Department of CS & IT, Trinity Dwarka was the second resource person for Day 6. She spoke on the topic "How to write a good Research Paper." She started the session with the concept and purpose of research paper. After that, she told about important factors of research writing and research writing structure. She discussed in detail the criteria to choose a research topic, outline of the paper, writing abstract, introduction, research gap, methodology, results & discussion and conclusion. She also highlighted AI tools e.g. chatpdf, Paperpal, Trinka, Plag.ai and Consensus that can be very useful inresearch.

After the session Dr. Mukta Sharma handled the queries of the participants and it was a very insightful session.

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At the end of session, Prof. Dr. Ashutosh Agarwal feciltated the resource person Dr. Naresh Kr. Vats and vote of thanks was proposed by Ms. Shruti, Assistant Professor, Trinity Dwarka.



Day 7 (23rd Nov, 23)

On the last day of the FDP, day 7, Dr. Sandhya Maitra, Deputy Director, Trinity Dwarka conducted a session on dimensions of research quality. She addressed the various aspects of research quality with respect to individual researcher, group of researchers as well as journal editors. She explained the 3 dimensions of quality – Research procedure quality, Research Presentaion Quality and Researching Quality and also discussed important quality parameters H Index, G Index, I Index, Eign factor, Cite score and Altmetric Attention score caluclations and limitations. The speaker gave a comprehensive view of the various measures used to ascertain quality of research and also proposed methods to enhance research quality. The session is indeed the need of the hour and an eyeopener for the researchers and academicians alike

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In the valedictory session of FDP on day 7, Prof. Dr. Nimisha Sharma, Director, R & D cell, GGSIP university was the guest of honour. In this session Prof. Dr. R. K. Tandon, Chairman, Trinity Dwarka congratulated the participants and organising team for successful completion of one week FDP. Session I



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

Day 4 (Thursday, 21 March, 2024)


Session I



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
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Session II


