Although it was a tiring day for the volunteers but this initiative helped them realize the





India became the first-ever country to have the Chess Olympiad Torch Relay. The torch will be taken to 75 cities over a span of 40 days before arriving in Mahabalipuram. At every location, chess grandmasters of the state will receive the torch. The Olympiad will take place in Mahabalipuram between 28 July and 10 August. The opening ceremony showcased the Indian



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values of Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam. Sports Minister Anurag Thakur was also present at the program. Woman Grand Master Koneru Humpy, legendary Viswanathan Anand, and FIDE President Arkady Dvorkovich also graced this event by their presence.
