- According to 100% of faculty, they feel the salary, leaves, and research facility, are given as per the norms
- As per 100% of faculty members' research is well-recognized is considered for promotions and is a part of the appraisal system
- According to 79.4% of the faculty, the overall academic environment is excellent, and according to 17.6%, it is very good, and around 2.9% it is good.



Q1. Campus Atmosphere Analysis


Responses for Q1. Campus Atmosphere

Q2. Academic Facilities Analysis


Responses for Q2. Academic Facilities

Q3. Discipline Analysis


Responses for Q3. Discipline

Q4. Quality of Teaching Analysis


Responses for Q4. Quality of Teaching

Q5. Co-Curricular Activtites Analysis


Responses for Q5. Co-Curricular Activtites

Q6. Extra-Curricular Activities Analysis



Q7. Student Assessment & Examination Analysis


Responses for Q7. Student Assessment & Examination

Q8. Institutional Support Analysis


Responses for Q8. Institutional Support

Q9. Training & Placement Support Analysis


Responses for Q9. Training & Placement Support
