It was a very enjoyable day and at the same time all the teachers took pledge that they will do justice with their profession

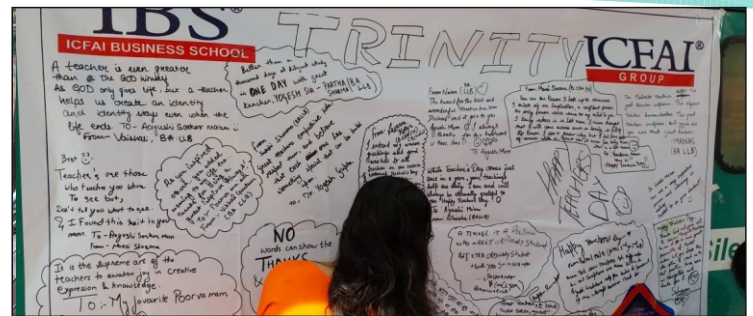
FRESHER'S PARTY- TRANSDUCTION 2018
