Narendra Modi Sworn in for Historic Third Term as Prime Minister

Terrorist Attack in Reasi

In this regard, the students and parents are demanding re-test and dozens of petitions have been filed in the court regarding the same. Firstly, the NTA (National Testing Agency) officials declined such irregularities but then the union education minister, Dharmendra Pradhan admitted that certain irregularities had come to light of the government he said that no one including the NTA officials would be pardoned in this case. The Supreme Court of India has also mentioned that even if there was 0.001 percent part of negligence by any official, it should not be neglected

came to an end around the 12th century due to repeated invasions by foreign powers. The invaders burned the university which led to its downfall and abandonment. The burning of the library of the university during the invasion is said to have lasted for several months. It led to the destruction of vast knowledge and scholarship.

The new campus of Nalanda University is constructed with all modern and eco-friendly facilities which include solar plants, water treatment plants, water recycling plants and many more. The vastness of the campus can be speculated from the fact that it comprises 2 academic blocks with 40 classrooms and a seating capacity of around 1900. It also has 2 auditoriums, a student hostel and international centre and an amphitheatre.

Cancellation of UGC-NET Exam 2024

The UGC NET June 2024 examination has been cancelled due to concerns regarding its integrity. Conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) on June 18, 2024, the University Grants Commission (UGC) received information from the National Cyber Crime Threat Analytics Unit about possible compromises in the exam's integrity.

To ensure transparency and fairness, the Ministry of Education decided to cancel the examination. The issue has been referred to the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) for a thorough investigation, and a new date for the exam will be announced by the NTA soon. This decision impacted around 9,08,580 candidates who took the exam. The government is committed to maintaining the sanctity of the examination process and will take strict action against those responsible for the compromise.

The Ministry of Education announced on its social media platform X, stating, "The government is committed

to ensuring the sanctity of examinations and protecting the interests of students. Based on inputs from the Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre (I4C) under the Ministry of Home Affairs, indicating that the integrity of the UGC-NET June 2024 examination may have been compromised, the Ministry of Education has decided to cancel the exam." The ministry also mentioned that the investigation has been handed over to the CBI and that information about the re-examination will be shared shortly.

The cancellation of the UGC NET June 2024 examination underscores the government's commitment to ensuring the fairness and integrity of national exams. This exam cancellation and NEET paper leaks scarred candidates as their future have become a huge concern now. It gave them a lot of mental pressure which they were not able to handle and started taking major steps. The government should take responsibility and look into all these types of irregularities and take steps to avoid such malpractices in conduct of examinations.

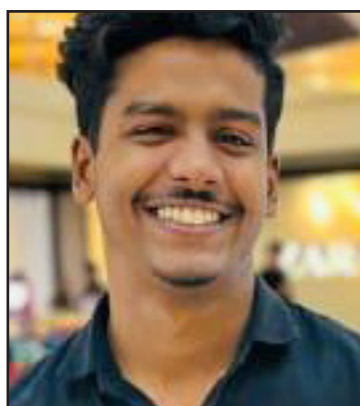

Empowering Women Through Awareness and Action

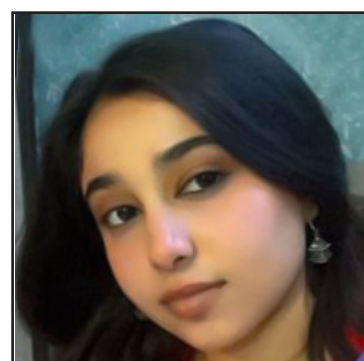

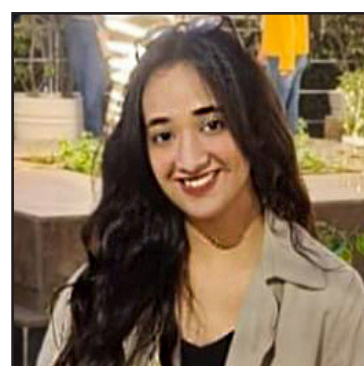

अमेरिकन सरकारी अखबार "वॉइस ऑफ अमेरिका" ने अपनी अखबार में यह लिखा 24 साल में किसी रूसी राष्ट्रपति का ये पहला उत्तर कोरिया दौरा है। रूस अपनी कठोर रक्षा नीति के कारण जाना जाता है, लेकिन प्रतिबंध के कारण रूस ने अब ठान लिया है कि वह चीन, उत्तर कोरिया जैसे देशों के साथ मिलकर पश्चिमी देशों एवं अमेरिका के खिलाफ



दो वर्ष से चली आ रही है यूक्रेन वॉर में अमेरिका ने जिस तरह से नाटो कंट्री के साथ मिलकर हथियार सप्लाई किया, उससे रूस काफी खफा है। अमेरिका ने रूस पर बहुत सारे प्रतिबंध लगाए और साथ ही पुतिन की गिरफ्तारी के लिए विश्व में वारंट निकलवा दिया।

पुतिन का हाल में चीन एवं उत्तर कोरिया का दौरा, वियतनाम एवं अमेरिका के लिए एक सिर दर्द बनके उभरा है। उत्तर कोरिया और रूस ने जिस रक्षा संधि पर हस्ताक्षर किए हैं, उसमें यह साफ है कि अगर उत्तर कोरिया पर हमला होता है, तो रूस उसे खुद पर हमला समझेगा। अगर उस पर हमला होता है तो उत्तर कोरिया उस पर कार्यवाही करेगा, रूस का प्रयास उत्तर कोरिया को रक्षा के मामले में पश्चिमी देशों के खिलाफ मजबूत करना है। उसे लंबी दूरी कि मारक वाली मिसाइल प्रदान करना है। यह संधि आज तक की रूस और

खुद को मजबूत करेगा। अमेरिका और बाकी नाटो देश के लिए यह एक कड़ा संदेश है, पुतिन का कहना है कि अगर दबाव और बना तो हम पश्चिमी देशों के दुश्मनों को लंबी दूरी वाली मिसाइल भी देंगे। पुतिन, जिनपिंग और किम जोंग एक वैश्विक लीडर बनके अमेरिका और बाकी पश्चिमी देशों के खिलाफ उभर रहे हैं। अब यह देखना रोचक होगा भारत की इस पर क्या प्रतिक्रिया होगी, भारत ने हमेशा तटस्थ नीति अपनाई है। रूस समय-समय पर भारत के साथ खड़ा रहा है, चाहे तो वह संयुक्त राष्ट्र हो या 1971 का वॉर, लेकिन रूस की नजदीकी चीन के साथ बढ़ने से भारत की विदेश नीति में बदलाव देखने को मिल सकता है या नहीं ये तो समय ही बताएगा। चीन के साथ भारत फिलहाल मजबूत रिश्ते बनाने के पक्ष में नहीं दिख रहा जब तक की चीन अपनी सेना उत्तरी पूर्व इलाकों से नहीं हटाता।
