India strengthens global agricultural partnerships at G20 Agri Ministerial Meeting in Brazil

During the G20 Agriculture Ministerial Meeting held from 12-13 September in Cuiabá, Brazil. India held a series of bilateral meetings with key global partners, including the US, Brazil, Japan, Germany, the UK, Spain and the UAE.

The discussions focused on multiple critical areas, such as climate-smart agriculture, food processing, trade barriers, and technological collaboration

The Indian delegation, led by the minister of state for Agriculture Ram Nath Thakur, pursued partnerships to strengthen its agricultural sector and address global challenges like food security and climate change, the agriculture ministry said.



address these concerns through joint efforts, the ministry release said.

Thakur held discussions with Japan's agriculture minister Sakamoto, focusing on technology, food processing, and market access. India sought the fast-tracking of pomegranates and grapes into the Japanese market, while Japan raised issues related to cedar wood exports.

In his meeting with Germany's parliamentary state secretary Ophelia Nick, Thakur emphasised the importance of regular India-German

engagements. Both sides agreed to enhance collaboration in artificial intelligence in farming, agroecology, and organic agriculture.

Bilateral talks with the UK's minister for food security, Daniel Zeichner, centered around transforming agriculture into a sustainable, tech-driven system. The UK expressed interest in India's agricultural extension services, while both sides agreed on precision breeding and gene-editing collaborations.

Genomic tech cooperation

In discussions with Spain's agriculture minister, Luis Planas, the focus was on resolving veterinary certificate issues and exploring cooperation in genomic techniques, water use efficiency, and climate-resilient farming. The UAE also expressed interest in collaborating on vertical farming and sustainable agriculture.

The G20 Leaders' Summit serves as a platform for international cooperation, fostering dialogue on critical issues that impact global growth, trade, and financial systems.

ICAR-EMBRAPA MoU

A major highlight was the meeting between Thakur and his Brazilian counterpart Carlos Fávaro. During the bilateral meeting, both nations reaffirmed their commitment to finalizing a memorandum of understanding (MoU) between the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) and Brazil's EMBRAPA, which is expected to be completed before the G20 leaders' summit in November, the ministry release said. Besides, Brazil expressed interest in collaborating on ethanol production technology, a crucial area for India's climate goals, it said.

Thakur raised market access issues, seeking entry for Indian agricultural products such as sorghum, rapeseed and cotton, while Brazil requested market access for citrus, it said, adding that both sides were hopeful about resolving trade obstacles.

Market access issues

India highlighted market access issues for fruits and vegetables, while the US requested expedited access for alfalfa hay fodder and both sides agreed to

Sanjay Roy, the accused who was arrested, allegedly denied taking the test. According to CBI sources, Roy had first consented to undergo the exam but then changed his mind.

The Prime Minister landed in the USA on 21st of September 2024. There he took part in the sixth Quad Leaders Summit, which was held in Wilmington, Delaware. Which was hosted by the President of the United States of America, Mr. Joe Biden. In his address, the Prime Minister thanked President Biden for hosting the Summit and for his personal commitment to

The officer continued, "We asked them some specific questions as well," and after about two hours, they departed for their homes.

Atishi takes over as new CM of Delhi

Atishi Marlena takes over as the new Chief Minister of Delhi after the resignation of Arvind Kejriwal. Her appointment was approved by Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) legislators during a meeting that led her as the third woman to hold this position, after Sushma Swaraj and Sheila Dikshit. At 42 years old, Atishi also became the youngest Chief Minister of Delhi.



Atishi has been a key figure in the Delhi government and previously held important

strengthen the Quad as a force for global good. He underlined that the Quad was here to stay, to assist, to partner and to complement the efforts of Indo-Pacific countries. Following the request of the US side to host the Quad Summit this year, India has agreed to host the next Quad Summit in 2025.

On 22nd September 2024, PM addressed over 15,000 people of the Indian community at an event in Long Island, New York.

The Prime Minister spoke about his vision for Viksit Bharat by 2047. This special gesture reflected the bridge of trust that the Indian community has built with the United States. PM also interacted with CEOs of leading US based

companies to foster greater collaborations between the two countries in the cutting-edge areas of AI, quantum computing, semiconductors and biotechnology.

The Prime Minister also interacted with thought leaders and other stakeholders active in the India-US bilateral landscape. Then on 23rd September 2024, Prime Minister arrived at the 79th U.N. General Assembly session to give his address at the Summit of the Future in New York, U.S. He said reforms in global institutions are important for global peace and development. The theme of the Summit was 'Multilateral Solutions for a Better Tomorrow'. On the sidelines of the Summit, Prime Minister would be holding bilateral meetings with several world leaders and discuss issues of mutual interest

City Name Changes in India: Liberation or Political Agenda?

In recent years, India has witnessed a wave of city name changes, sparking debates on whether these revisions represent liberation from colonial and Mughal legacies or are driven by political agendas.

The trend began in the early 21st century, with significant name changes like Calcutta to Kolkata in 2001, aligning the name with its Bengali roots. Similarly, Pondicherry became Puducherry to reflect local linguistic heritage.

However, since 2019, the pace of name changes has accelerated.

Cities like Allahabad have been renamed Prayagraj, Aurangabad to Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar, and Faizabad to Ayodhya. These alterations are often framed as an effort to reclaim cultural identity from the imprints of British colonial and Mughal rule. Proponents argue that the renaming honors India's historical heritage and local culture, while critics suggest it is part of a broader political agenda to revise history and garner nationalist sentiment.

The debate over these changes continues, with some viewing it as a meaningful step towards decolonization, while others see it as a distraction from more pressing socio-economic issues. The line between cultural revival and political maneuvering remains blurred.

विधानसभा चुनाव - जम्मू कश्मीर, महाराष्ट्र, हरियाणा एवं झारखंड की स्थिति?

इस साल भारत के कई राज्यों में चुनाव होना है जिसमें हरियाणा, जम्मू-कश्मीर, महाराष्ट्र और झारखंड शामिल है। चुनाव आयोग ने 16 अगस्त 2024, को घोषणा करते हुए बताया कि हरियाणा और जम्मू-कश्मीर के लिए विधानसभा चुनाव 18 सितंबर से 1 अक्टूबर तक होंगे। मौजूदा विधानसभाओं का कार्यकाल 3 नवंबर (हरियाणा), 26 नवंबर (महाराष्ट्र) और 5 जनवरी, 2025 (झारखंड) को समाप्त होगा और इनका कार्यकाल पूरा होगा। कार्यकाल पूरा होने से पहले चुनाव कराए जाने आवश्यक है।

4 राज्यों में विधानसभा चुनावों से पहले न्यूज चैनल "आज तक" ने "सी - वोट" के साथ मिलकर जनता का मूड जानने के लिए सर्वे किया है। इस सर्वे का नाम है "मूड ऑफ द नेशन"। सर्वे में हरियाणा, जम्मू कश्मीर, महाराष्ट्र, झारखंड चुनाव के अप्रत्याशित नतीजे सामने आए हैं। सर्वे में सवाल था कि अगर आज आम चुनाव हुए तो कौन जीतेगा? नतीजे

बताते हैं कि (एनडीए) को वोट मिलने की संभावनाएं 44% हैं। उन्हें 299 सीटें मिल सकती हैं। वहीं इंडिया ब्लॉक को 40% वोट और 233 सीटें मिलने का अनुमान है। अन्य दलों को 16% वोट और 11 सीटें मिल सकती हैं। इससे हमें ये पता लगता है कि मुकाबला काफी कड़ा है। एनडीए और इंडिया ब्लॉक के बीच वोट प्रतिशत में ज्यादा अंतर नहीं है।

जम्मू कश्मीर के चुनावी मंजर को देख हो रही है क्योंकि 370 के कुछ खंड हटाए जाने के बाद अब जम्मू कश्मीर में चुनाव होने जा रहे हैं। 'मूड ऑफ द नेशन' की माने तो 47% लोगों का कहना है कि बेरोजगारी अहम मुद्दा होगा। जम्मू कश्मीर में 10 साल बाद चुनाव होने जा रहे हैं और इसमें सारी पार्टियां दिलचस्पी दिखा रही हैं। "मूड ऑफ द नेशन" सर्वे के अनुसार महबूबा मुफ्ती की अगुवाई वाली (पीडीपी) को बढ़त मिल रही है।

Chandrayaan -3 exposed a creator on Earth’s natural satellite “moon”

Chandrayaan-3 is India’s third lunar mission, successfully launched by the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO). The mission made history by

achieving a soft landing on the Moon’s south pole on August 23, 2023. This accomplishment made India the first country to reach the Moon’s south pole and the fourth to land on the Moon overall.

The mission’s landing module consists of the Vikram lander and the Pragyan rover. After landing, the Pragyan rover explored the lunar surface, collecting important data and samples. One significant discovery made by the Pragyan rover

is identifying a crater with a diameter of about 160 km near the Moon’s south pole. This discovery is valuable because it provides insights into the Moon’s geological history.

The Moon is considered a natural satellite formed approximately 4.5 billion years ago. Previous lunar studies, including those conducted by NASA and other space agencies, have revealed various geological formations. Chandrayaan-3’s findings contribute to understanding the Moon’s early history and evolution. This mission has brought significant recognition to ISRO and has added valuable data to lunar research.

Mpox cases in India

After the deadly global pandemic caused by the coronavirus, a new global public health emergency was declared by WHO. Mpox, previously known as monkeypox, is a communicable illness that is caused by the monkeypox virus, an enveloped double-stranded DNA virus of the orthopoxvirus genus. It was discovered in 1958, in Denmark, in monkeys kept for research. Its first reported human case was a nine-month-old boy in the Democratic Republic of Congo, in 1970.

In August 2024, WHO declared Mpox “a public health emergency of international concern” following its outbreak in the democratic republic of Congo and other neighboring areas.

This is the second time in

two years, that Mpox has been declared a public health emergency, the first time in 2022.

Since the 2022 declaration, 30 cases of Mpox are reported in India. The latest case comes from a 38-year-old youth who landed in Kerala last week from UAE. WHO, has stated that the recovery time from Mpox is 2-4 weeks. By maintaining cleanliness, personal hygiene, and being cautious, we can minimize the risk of diagnosis. Practicing



social distancing, wearing masks, avoiding crowds, etc can also help reduce the risk of prognosis.
