The outcome of the discussions on the meeting agenda points are:

Agenda Point 1) Review of last IQAC meeting

Resolution/Outcome: A review report of the follow up actions taken on the resolutions of the last IQAC meeting was done by IQAC coordinator which was acknowledged by the present members without further comments. The IQAC cell was informed about an eminent lecture series on "Law is an instrument of social change" organised by Department of Legal Studies on 12th Jan 2023.

Agenda Point 2) NAAC Visit

Resolution/Outcome: The IQAC coordinator announced the meeting about the NAAC visit happening in the next month on 3rd & 4th May. The Self Study Report for 2nd Cycle of Accreditation are discussed in length and the concerns are highlighted by each member associated for the purpose. All the points for each criterion are briefed by the concerned members and some issues are raised in some criterion. The discussion under this agenda continued for fair enough time and the concerned issues are sorted. However, for some other concerns, it has been suggested for criteria wise in-house meeting with the IQAC coordinator in a day or two for detailed input & discussion.

Agenda Point 3) Value-Added Course

Resolution/Outcome: As per the agenda, the cell was informed by the concerned member that the recently completed 100 hour value added course by CS & IT was a huge success. In this regard the IQAC chairperson praised the initiative and encouraged others to follow the same suit. In this connection, the cell was informed about two proposed value added courses coming up in the next few days- which are a) by BA(J&MC) on Digital Marketing & Analytics in collaboration with Seekho, to be conducted offline, b) by Management & Commerce with support from Institute for Industrial Development Incubator under PPP mode with MSME, Government of India. Also the concerned member informed of the ongoing value add-on course organised by the Department of Legal Studies, in collaboration with District Legal Services Authority(DLSA), South West Delhi. The beneficiary participant students are from non-law department as to orient them in various legal aspects. The members suggest and discussed on different aspects of enriching the students in their respective domains by providing various skill development and value-added training programs.

Agenda Point 4) Planning of Placement activities

Resolution/Outcome: The IQAC cell discussed on the placement drives recently conducted and their outcomes which was shared by the concerned member with the present members. The successful completion of the HR Conclave on 1st April'23 has been praised by every member present. However, the proposed upcoming drives in the pipeline are shared and discussed in brief. It has been informed to the cell that Institution's Innovation Council cell was installed on 21st Feb 2023 with the motive to promote and nurture, encourage, inspire young students by supporting them to work with new ideas and transform them into prototype. All praised the initiative and discussed on how to strengthen the Innovation cell.

Agenda Point 5) Tech-Samaaroh 3.0

Resolution/Outcome: The organization of IT Fest, Tech-Samaaroh 3.0 by the department of CS & IT department on 18th March is discussed in the meeting. The members were informed about the 8 different events/competitions wherein students from more than 15 outside institutions took part. The attendees of the meeting were also shared with the learning outcomes from the organisation & conduct of the IT fest after the Covid pandemic phase. The members gave their inputs and suggested for idea events to be implemented in future endeavours.

Agenda Point 5) Others

Resolution/Outcome: With the permission of the chairperson, the cell discussed on the different institutional social responsibility and other social outreach programs conducted by the NSS cell of the institute. The recent visit to Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh representing Delhi contingent by our NSS-in charge faculty along with NSS volunteers of the UT to participate in the National Integration Camp organised from 18th March to 24th March has been reported in the meeting. It is informed that the NSS cell has recently conducted a 7 days camp for activities such as Eye check-up camp and Talent hunt for Slum kids, legal awareness campaign for slum people & yoga session with nutrition advice for Slum kids. The IQAC cell is shared with many other numerous activities related to personal wellness, societal welfare related programs, such as Stress Management & Personality Development,
