Q6.	The credits allocated to the syllabus were appropriate.

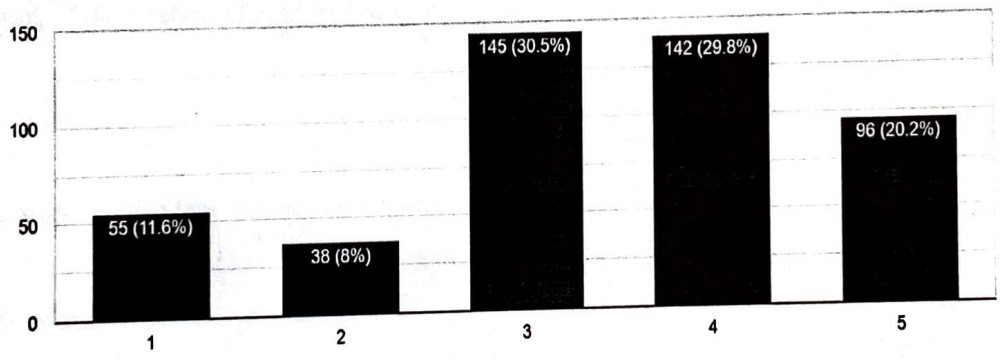
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Q7.	The Summer Internship Project provided an opportunity for Hands on training .

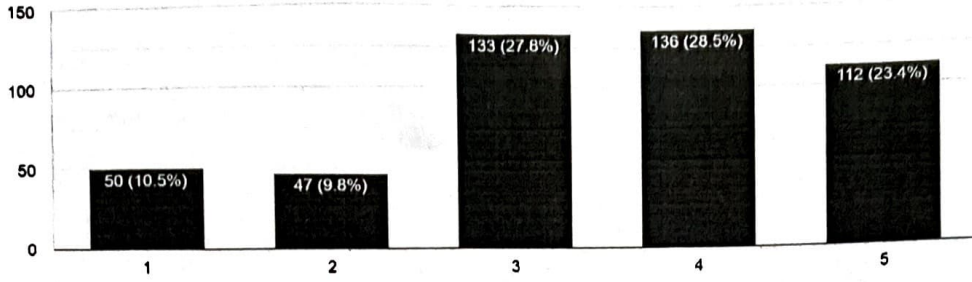
Q1.Depth of syllabus content was adequate.

Summary of the Analysis of Student Feedback:

2. The courses' design falls short in terms of additional or self-learning.
3. With the development of technology, there is less freedom in selecting electives.

- 5.More Practical Exposure, like addition of industry visits, court visits etc.
- 6.Inclusion of Value added courses, seminars, college fair.

4. For practical exposure court visits, lok adalat visit and industry visits are initiated.

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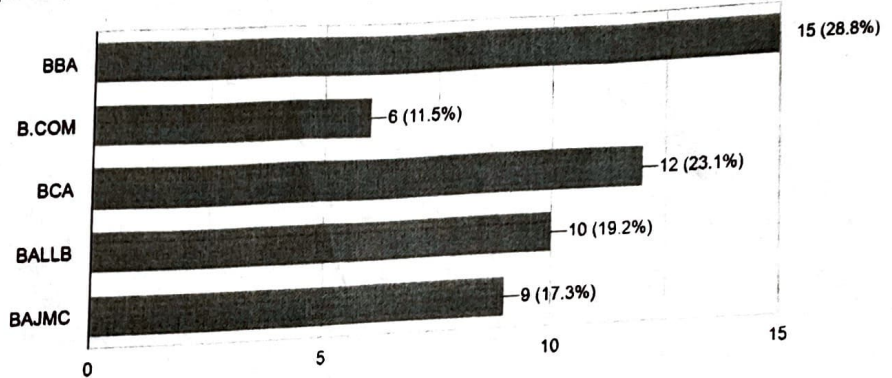
5. Organisation of seminars, webinars and eminent lecture series are in progress.

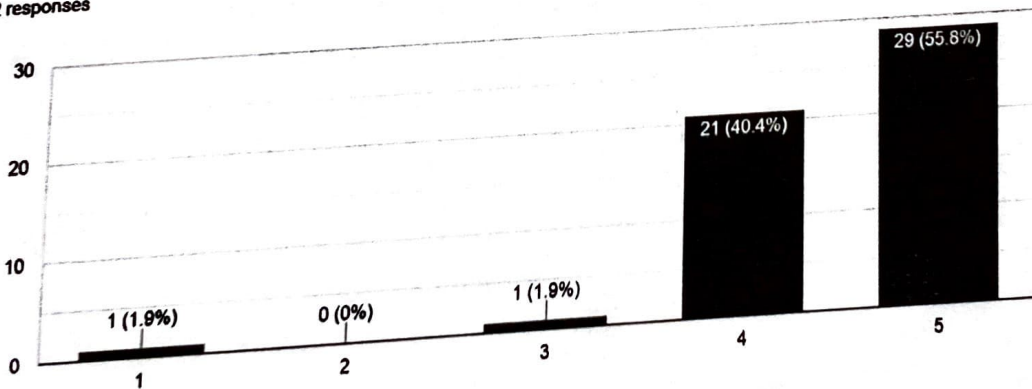

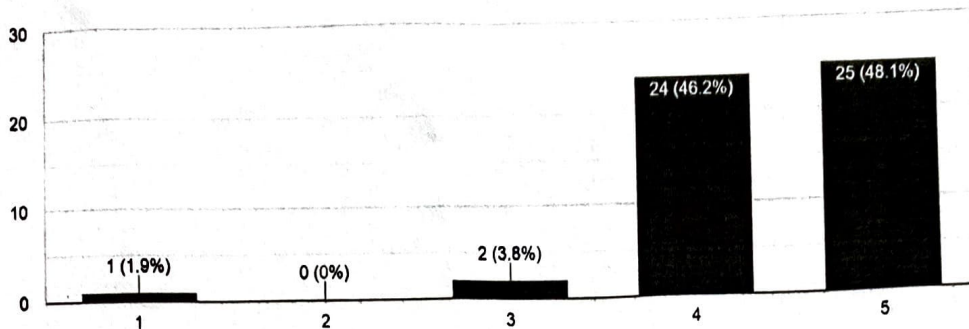


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Q2.The syllabus provided was career orientation.

2. The syllabus content for the courses in terms of the burden on students is excess.

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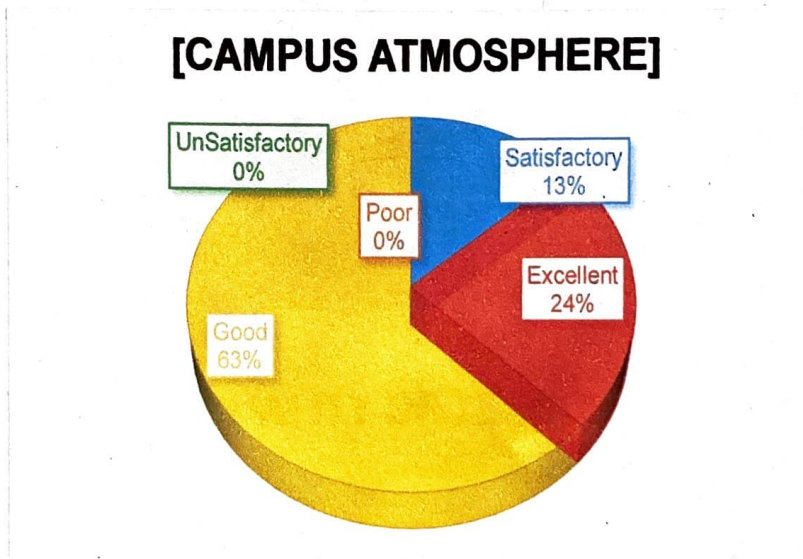

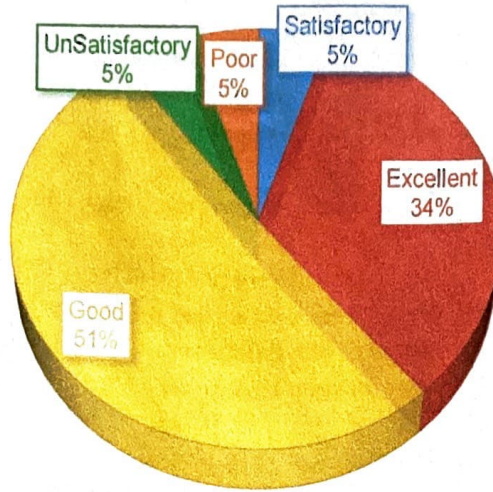

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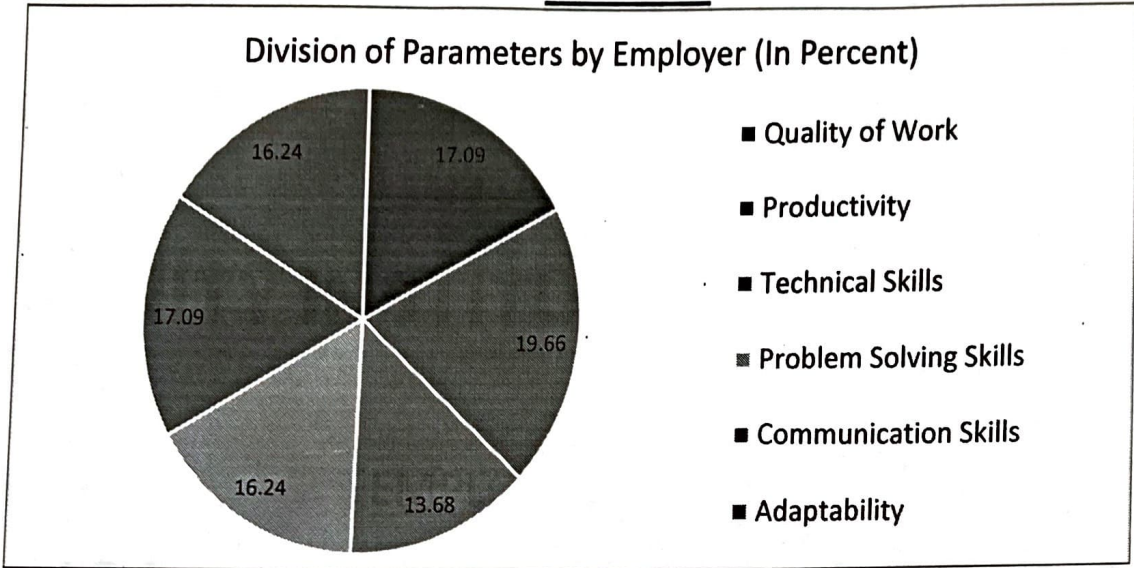
ACTION TAKEN REPORT

1. Training & Placement Cell has been formulated and more attention is given on industry linkages, more industrial visits, are planned in the future.
