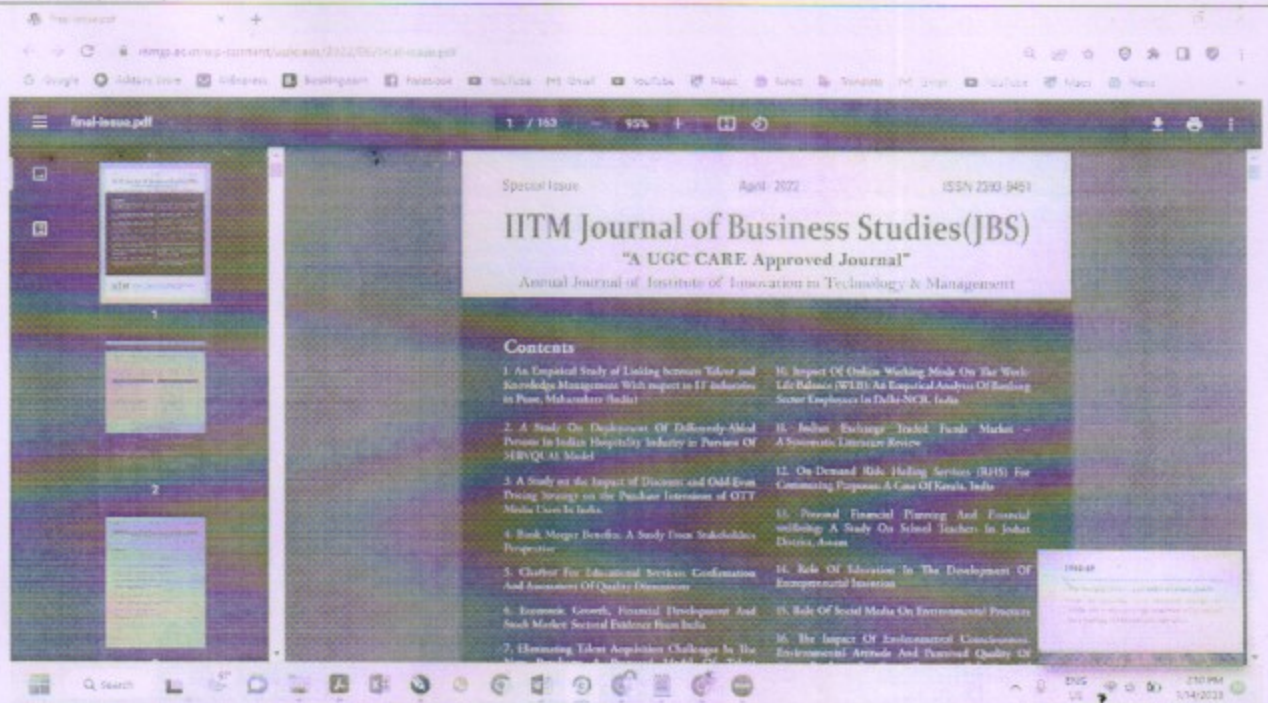

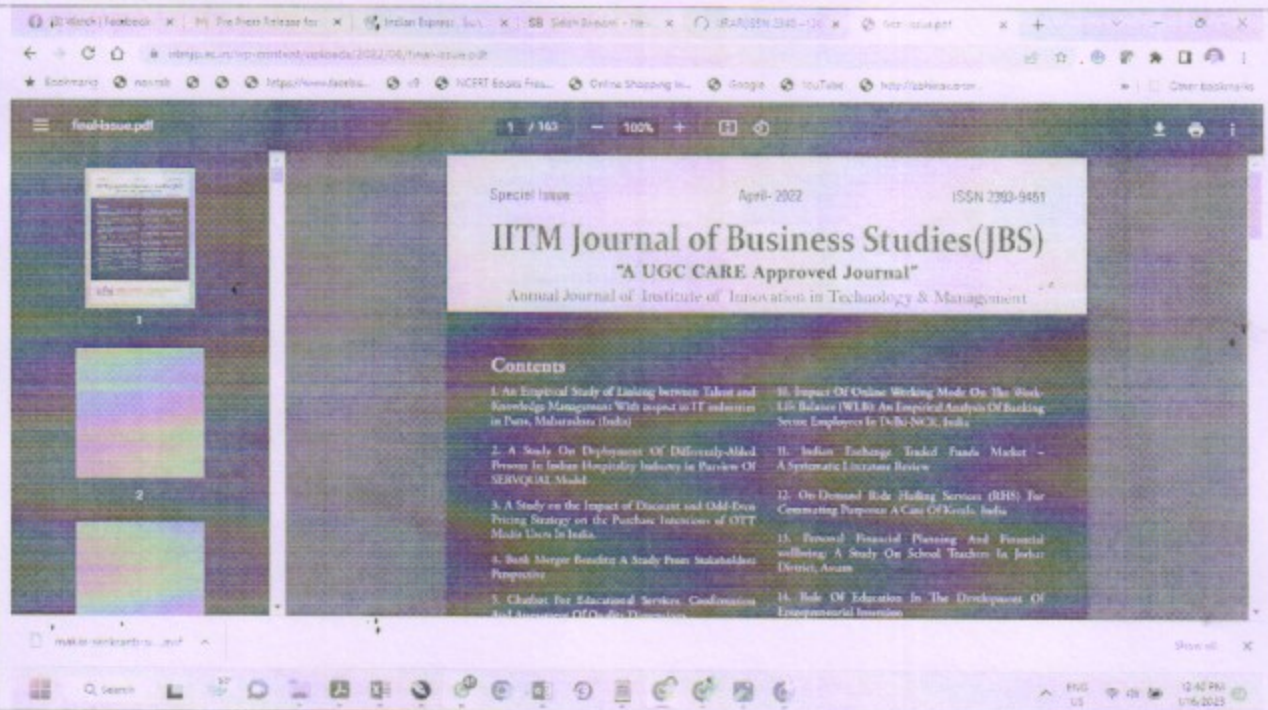

Introduction:



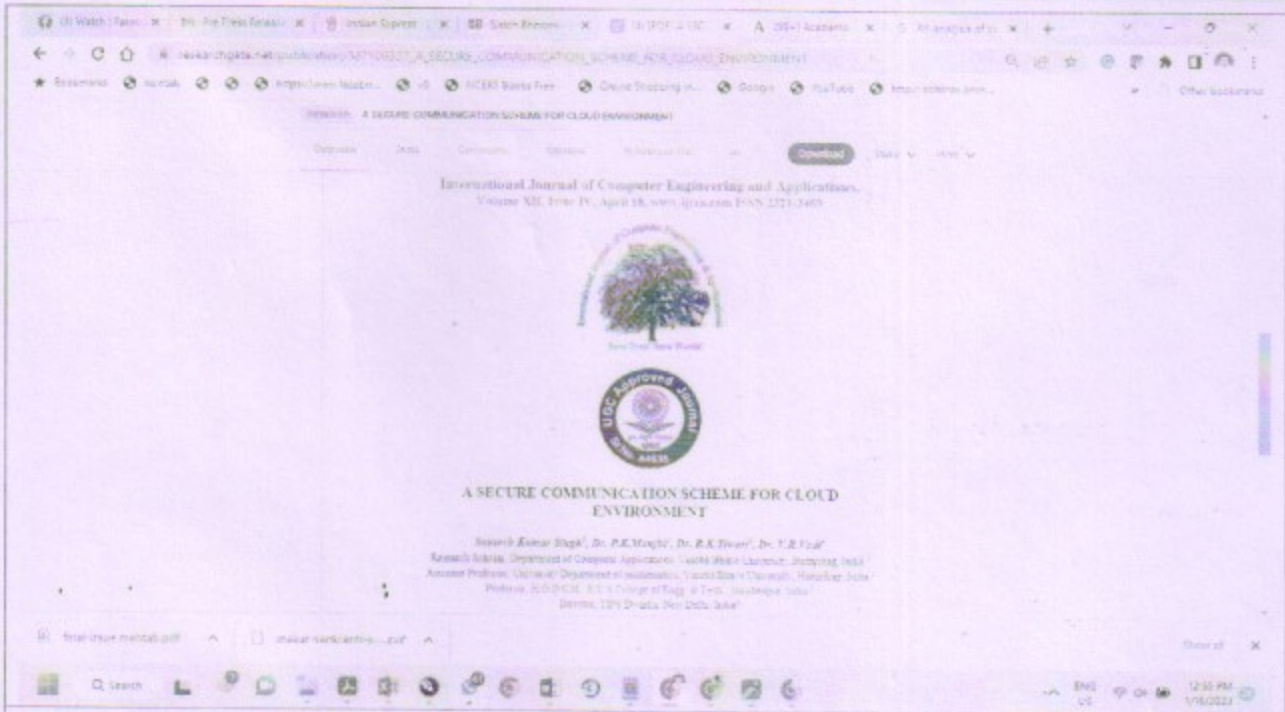

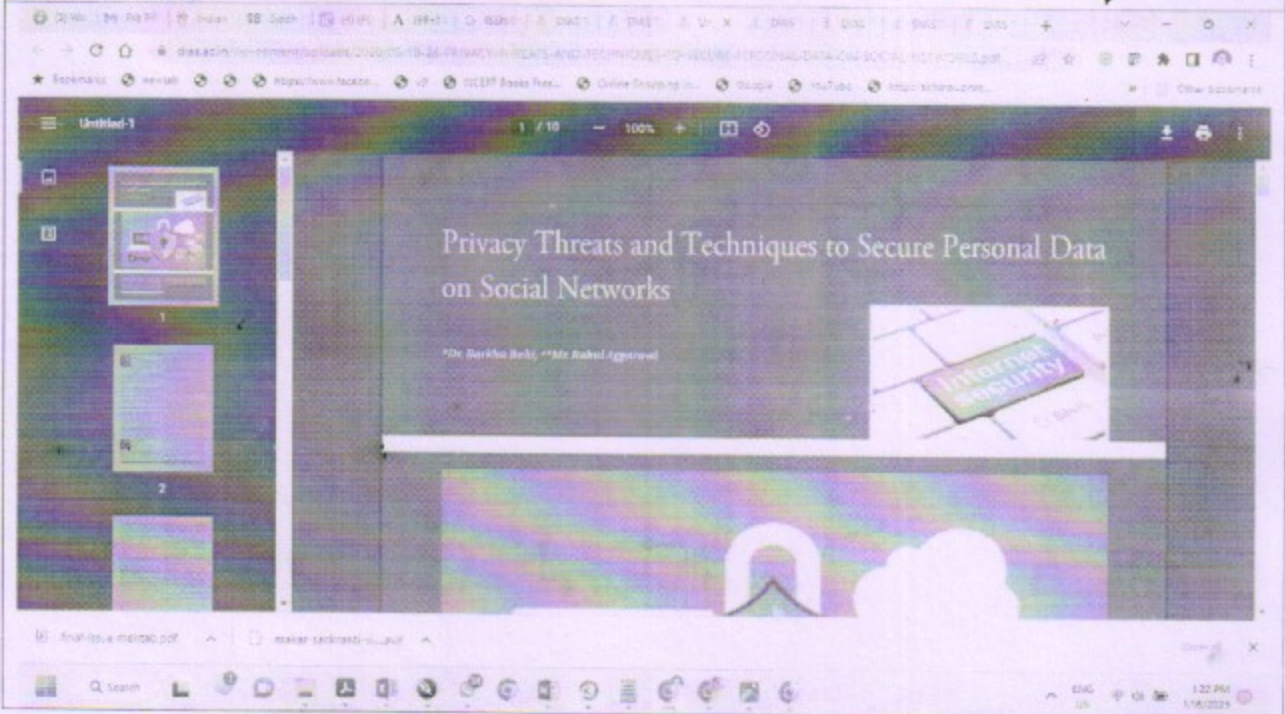
ABSTRACT

Spiritual intelligence refers to the ability to understand, appreciate, and practice spiritual values and principles. It is a holistic approach to life that encompasses the mind, body, and spirit. This paper explores the role of spiritual intelligence in teaching excellence in higher education institutes of Delhi & NCR. The study is based on a survey of 100 faculty members from various institutes. The results show that spiritual intelligence is positively correlated with teaching excellence.
